
We look forward to welcoming you to spectacular live entertainment in 2022. The LEC is a place where wonderful experiences

Function spaces at LEC

Our versatile function spaces are available for hire and can cater for events large or small.

Auditorium

The auditorium is capable of catering for theatre and musical productions, concerts, banquets, award ceremonies, conferences and trade shows. It has removable tiered seating and a customisable stage (maximum seated capacity 1,067).

Meeting Rooms

The LEC has 4 meeting rooms, each capable of supporting audio-visual requirements set in a variety of styles. These rooms are separated by an operable wall, allowing a larger meeting space or extension of the foyer.

Pre-Function/Lounge Bar

The size of the auditorium can be reduced to create a pre-function area (Lounge Bar) with access to both the auditorium and meeting rooms. This fully licensed area is ideal for cocktail receptions and informal gatherings.

Limelight

Limelight is the ideal venue for intimate events such as corporate functions, Christmas parties, seminars, cocktail parties, weddings, birthdays and any other special occasion.

Located at the end of the LEC's forecourt, Limelight can accommodate alfresco dining, cocktail or formal/informal sit-down dining experiences.

Plan your visit

Getting there

The LEC is a 35 minute drive from Brisbane City, 40 minutes from the Brisbane Airport off Pacific Motorway Exit 23 and 45 minutes from the Gold Coast off Pacific Motorway Exit 31.

Accommodation is available within a 15 minute drive from the centre.

Public transport is also available to the LEC via bus, train (Woodridge Train Station), or taxi/Uber. Please visit: translink.com.au to map your journey.

Parking

The LEC has ample free onsite car parking available for your convenience. There are two designated parking areas for guests. The one at the front of the building holds around 70 cars, while the second carpark at the rear of the building holds a further 300 car spaces.





Proof of concession

Discounted tickets are available to fulltime secondary and tertiary students undertaking Austudy, Abstudy or Queensland TAFEs, universities and other approved educational institutions are eligible for concession. Student cards must be shown upon entry.

Pensioners holding a current valid Pensioner Concession Card or Queensland Repatriation Health Gold Card issued by Centrelink or Department of Veteran's Affairs are eligible for concession. (*The 'Health Care Card' issued by Centrelink is not accepted.*) Seniors holding a Queensland Seniors Card are also eligible for concession. Valid concession cards must be presented upon entry.

Holders of a Queensland Seniors Business Discount Card are not entitled to concession rates.

Companion card

Concession rates are available to Companion Card holders for selected performances, plus the companion may enter free of charge. The card must be presented at time of booking or the Companion Card ID provided for phone bookings. A valid card must be presented on entry.

Accessibility

Accessible parking is available with 6 designated spaces at the front of the building and three designated spaces at the back of the building. Please ensure your pass is clearly displayed when parking in these spaces.

Mobility assistance



The centre has ramp access down to the main entry to assist people in a wheelchair or parents with prams. Our foyer and corridors are of sufficient width to fit wheelchairs and prams. Lift access to the balcony seating area from the foyer allows for easy and safe access between levels.

Our theatre provides seats for patrons who use wheelchairs or have other mobility requirements. If you wish to access these, please advise the Box Office when booking.

Hearing assistance

LEC has PA amplification suitable for people with hearing aids. If required, individual radio devices for hearing amplification can be accessed free of charge from the Box Office prior to performance.
