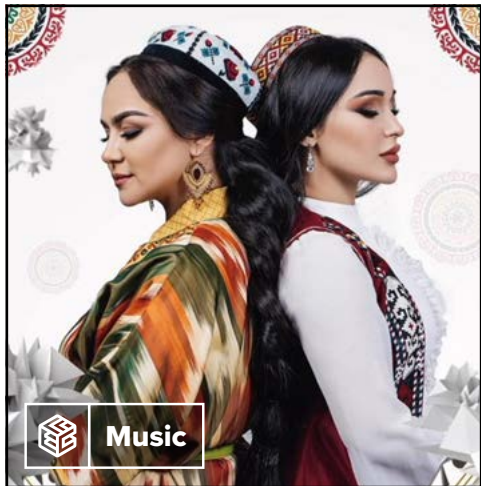

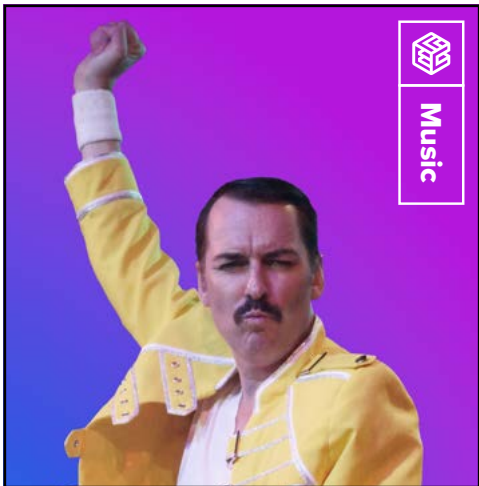
Nigina and Madina Australia Tour 2023

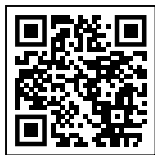

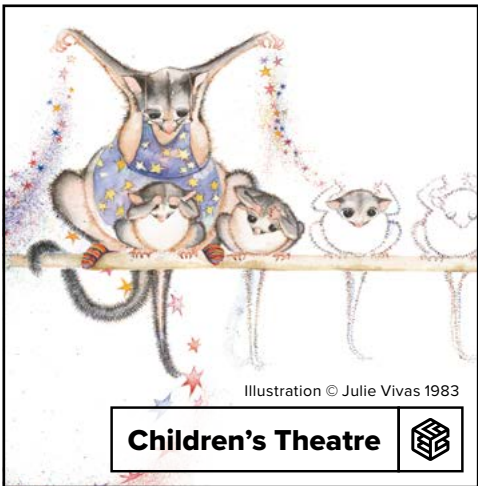
Jonathon Welch – A Hard Knock Life

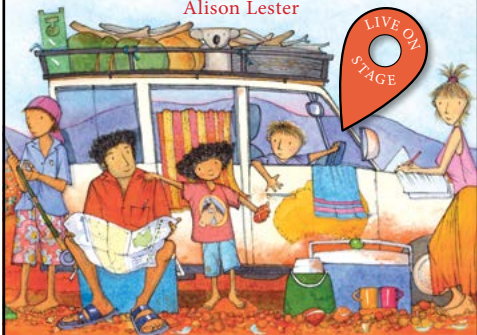
