EISTEDDFOD RULES

IT IS IMPORTANT THAT EVERY COMPETITOR & TEACHER READS THESE RULES AND CONDITIONS On entering the Eisteddfod, you will have been deemed to accept these conditions of entry.

General Eisteddfod Rules

- 1. Specific rules must be read in conjunction with these general rules.
- 2. This Eisteddfod is open only to persons whose main income is not derived from the area in which they enter.
- 3. Contestants must be prepared to perform in a Champions concert or Partners event if requested to do so.
- 4. Age of competitor is as at **1st January** of year of competition.
- 5. It is the performer's responsibility to check the program for performance venues, dates and times. Competitors must report to the Marshal on arrival at the Eisteddfod venue.
- 6. Competitors must be present at the **beginning of the session** as withdrawals may alter the order and anticipated time of a performance. It is unwise to anticipate exact performance times.
- Solo competitors may compete only once in any section (unless specifically stated otherwise). Students may perform more than once in duo, trio, quartet but NOT consisting of identical competitors in any one section (unless specifically stated otherwise).
- 8. Groups may compete more than once in any section.
- 9. In all Duo, Trio and Quartet sections, the names of ALL entrants must be on the Entry Form.
- 10. The committee has the right to alter or amend the program in any way at any time, to refuse entry, cancel any entry or cancel any section where entries are insufficient. To enhance competition there must be more than TWO entries in a section. In sections where there is only ONE entry, the competitor will be upgraded to the next age group.
- 11. Competitor numbers must be sufficient before any cash prizes will be awarded in any section. Unless there are at least four competitors in a section, only one prize will be awarded, unless the adjudicator decides otherwise.
- 12. Group entries must be entered in the oldest performer's age group.
- 13. TIME LIMITS for each section MUST be observed. An item may be shorter than the time limit but not exceed it. Competitors will not be adjudicated after the set time has elapsed and may be asked to stop performing after the time limit.
- 14. CENSORSHIP The use of costume, words, subject matter or actions which include suicide or murder that is explicit or of a sexual nature is prohibited as these are regarded as unacceptable in a family environment and will result in the disqualification of the competitor at the adjudicator's discretion. This includes dance and the sexualisation of movements – performances and material must be age appropriate.
- 15. Competitors or teachers, interested parties, or any other persons, must not communicate with the Adjudicator.
- 16. No competitor may perform out of programmed sequence without the approval of the convenor.
- 17. Competitors may bring their own accompanist except where stated otherwise.
- The committee has the right to appoint a substitute Adjudicator and the Adjudicator's decision is final. To be read in conjunction with Rule 25.
- 19. Quota Beenleigh Inc. will not be responsible for copyright and royalty infringements. Please download the Copyright Declaration Form from our website, complete and bring the declaration along with the performance copy, if applicable.

- 20. Mobile phones must be switched off in backstage and dressing room areas at all venues. No cameras allowed in these areas. Mobile phones and other recording devices are prohibited for recording in all venues. BWP Studios allowed.
- 21. All competitors enter the Eisteddfod and take part in the Eisteddfod at their own risk and are responsible for their own belongings.
- 22. Backstage and dressing rooms are to be left in a clean and tidy manner.
- 23. Entry fees are NOT refundable.
- 24. Performers, parents, guardians and teachers are expected to behave in a mature and socially acceptable manner.
- 25. Any protest or objection must be referred to the Convenor within 30 minutes of the Adjudicator's decision. The protest must be submitted by the competitor, teacher or parent and accompanied by a \$50 fee. The fee will be refunded if the claim is found to be valid. The committee reserves the right to request a copy of the competitor's birth certificate if the dispute is age related.
- 26. Teachers are allowed on stage only as accompanists or conductors for choirs or for items requiring stage set-up.
- 27. Only designated teachers and performers are permitted back of house at the Logan Entertainment Centre.
- 28. Failure to comply wholly or partly with any of the rules or conditions may result in disqualification or the withholding of prizes. The decision of the committee on any question or dispute shall be absolutely final. The committee shall decide any matter not covered by the rules or conditions and their decision is final.
- 29. This Eisteddfod is held in a spirit of friendly competition and good sportsmanship. Canvassing by Studio Owners, Teachers, Competitors or Parents to change a competitor's place of enrolment is regarded as bad sportsmanship and will not be tolerated.
- 30. Care will be taken for the safety of all competitors, but the Eisteddfod will not be responsible for any injuries sustained by a competitor or damage to property during the Eisteddfod.
- 31. **PROPS**: Only props that are hand-held and can be taken onto the stage by the competitors are permitted. To be fair to all performers, **props which are larger than hand-held will not be permitted to be used to avoid embarrassment, please do not bring these props to the venue.**
- 32. Only performers, teachers or designated assistants, wearing a performer's or teacher's pass, will be permitted into the backstage area at Logan Entertainment Centre.
- 33. Competitor's passes are compulsory for each performer and must be purchased at the time of entry additional passes may be purchased at the venue or by contacting <u>eisteddfod@quotabeenleigh.org.au</u>



Specific Rules for Music Groups

- 1. Please read the General Eisteddfod Rules carefully before reading these Specific Rules.
- 2. All required Music/Sheet Music must be uploaded using the appropriate method
- 3. Please bring a back-up on a USB or smart device in the rare case there is a problem with the music.
- 4. It is your responsibility to check that the music is correct after uploading pages in the correct order, and right way up (portrait).
- 5. In Vocal sections accompanying music must not contain vocal backing.
- 6. Groups will be allocated a room or designated space in which to rehearse and keep their belongings.
- 7. A piece of music may not be used more than once by the same group.
- 8. A copy of all music notation (vocals should include notation as well as words) clearly labelled with competitor number and section number are to be uploaded. Please ensure that all pages are the correct way up.
- 9. Titles and Composers must be included on all supplied music.
- 10. NO tuning is allowed on stage or side stage.
- 11. Criteria for Beginners, Intermediate and Advanced bands is based on chosen music.
- 12. Conductors must not sing.
- 13. ALL Drummers MUST supply their own drumsticks.
- 14. The piano will be "in situ" on the stage, and will not be moved without prior approval
- 15. Where a very large number of competitors nominate for a section, the Committee reserves the right to split that Section. Requests to change competitors in sections will not be accepted.

DEFINITION OF MUSIC TERMS

SACRED SONG	May include hymns, religious or worship songs, gospel songs, spirituals or
	arias containing sacred themes.

MUSICAL STAGE OR FILM A song from a film or stage musical, must be in costume.

CHANGES TO ENTRIES

We ask that you please check your entries are correct at the time of entry. Making changes is very time consuming for our convenors. This year, any changes made after the closing date will incur a \$22 fee for each change. This will be invoiced, and the changes will be made after payment has been received.





String Orchestra/Ensembles



Equipment is supplied at Logan Entertainment Centre

The following band equipment will be supplied in addition to the Baby Grand Piano:

- 1 digital piano
- 3 Timpani
- 1 bass drum
- 1 snare drum
- 1 glock
- 1 xylophone
- 1 drum kit
- Traps table
- Bass amp
- Guitar amp
- 2 congas
- 25 music stands

You will be required to bring any other instruments or equipment – please note to bring extra music stands if you require more than 25 stands.

NO drumsticks are supplied

SETTING-UP

The time limit allowed is performance time, from when a group starts performing until the players exit the stage. Only 5 minutes extra has been allowed per group for setting up.

MUSIC UPLOADS

The Eisteddfod is using Music Uploads to manage the music files, sheet music, performance pieces and voice critiques – this approach is a great way to streamline the processes to ensure longevity of the Eisteddfod.

This means that you do not need to bring music on USBs or CDs or paper files for sheet music and performance pieces. All music will be played from a central computer. We do recommend that you always have a back-up of your files on your phone or tablet in case there is any technology issues.

Please note that studio accounts are not for adding solo performers. Parents will need to create an account and upload performance pieces for solo performers.

Step 1 – View the Music Uploads Videos - Music Uploads YouTube Channel

Step 2 – Create an Account (if you do not already have one) or Reactivate your Account (if you have previously used Music Uploads).

Step 3 – Add the Region (Competition) – you will need to pay for each competition you add.

- Step 4 Upload Files to Storage
- Step 5 Transfer the Files to the Region (Competition)

Step 6 – Create or Search for a Performer and review that all entries are correct.

Step 7 – Transfer the files for the Performer

Step 8 - **Check your Files** – ensure it is the correct music and that a document file has all pages the correct way up.

Step 9 – If you wish to **withdraw** an entry, please use that option in Music Uploads and our team will be notified.

Once the program has been set, we will advise when we are ready for you to upload your files. At that time, we will provide a closing date for Music Uploads.

Teachers Passes





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VOCAL ADJUDICATOR – D'ARNE SLEEMAN



D'Arne Sleeman is a graduate of the Queensland Conservatorium, Griffith University and based in Brisbane. Her portfolio of performances, ranges in genre from opera, recital repertoire and live theatre, to the role of cantor in the Brisbane Catholic dioceses. She is a recognised artist with Opera Queensland and has appeared in over fifty mainstage productions.

She began adjudicating in 2012, to regions up and down the East Coast of Australia, working with Eisteddfods, both regional and national,

as well as the International Music Examination Board.

In 2024 engagements include Townsville, Toowoomba, Burdekin eisteddfods and for the Queensland Vocal Competition.

D'Arne enjoyed her first taste of feature films, onscreen in Thor: Ragnarok, recordings have included Opera's Greatest Choruses with Opera Queensland and Brisbane Chamber Choir Mass of the Dreaming.

Within her freelance career, D'Arne is a regular entertainer at corporate events and includes performing the New Zealand National Anthem at the Bledisloe Cup within her performance reel. She toured Queensland as part of the renowned Morning Melodies series and produced workshops and education shows for Queensland Festival of Bands touring central Queensland.

Other performances have included international engagements in Cortona, Italy, Wales and London, and within Australia, Operatif, Underground Opera, Kelvin Grove Wind Orchestra and the Army Band.

An outstanding concert flutist/ pianist with virtuosity and expressiveness.


Maggie Chen is the International Ambassador of the Queensland Conservatorium Griffith University, where her piano duo was the Ensemble in Residence at. Maggie is a current examiner for the Australia Music Examination Board (AMEB) and the Vice President of the Queensland Flute Guild, where she regularly gets invited to adjudicate competitions and scholarships.

Maggie graduated as one of the top 3% and the youngest student at Queensland Conservatorium Griffith University at the age of 19 with a Bachelor of Music in Advanced Performance with First Class Honors. Her competition success comprises many first prizes and scholarships, including the Basil Jones Sonata Prize, the Margaret Nickson Prize, the Hilda Woolmer Prize, the Merit Scholarship, the Most Outstanding Music Performance award, Australian Postgraduate Awards, Queensland Flute Guild Competitions, Kaohsiung Piano Competition, Taiwan Chinese Flute Competition, Yamaha Piano Competition, the International Scholarship for Music, the Griffith Award for Academic Excellence and many other academic awards. Apart from performing and adjudicating, Maggie also teaches flute and piano, as well as running her own private music studio. She has worked in universities and schools including the University of New Castle, NSW (guest artist); University of Queensland (guest artist); Dahcherng School of Music for Talents (guest professor), the QLD Conservatorium of Music, Yamaha Music School, Joviality Music School and the Conservatorium of Music, University of Tasmania (guest artist).



Additionally, she has also worked with the Kaohsiung Philharmonic Symphony Orchestra, Brisbane Philharmonic Orchestra, Tainan Symphony Orchestra and the Queensland Orchestra (Internship).

Maggie regularly gets invited to perform, present masterclasses and adjudicate competitions and scholarships around the globe. She has been invited to perform solo and with orchestra in Australia, Hong Kong, China, Singapore, Japan, Germany and Vienna. Maggie is also an active chamber musician, appearing on newspapers, TV shows and recording for radio stations both nationally and internationally.






